Madigan Company, Inc. They are active in the Worcester business community and their local parishes. Fran's son Andrew is a freshman at Saint John's, and Andrew's younger brother and cousins (Jim's boys) hope to continue the family tradition at Saint John's.

Through their gifts to their scholarship fund, the Madigans built a generous legacy at Saint John's. For nearly 30 years, they have helped boys from Central Massachusetts enjoy the benefits of a Saint John's education. Now, to honor their parents and the ties that bind the Madigan family with the Saint John's family, Fran and Jim have pledged to double the Madigan Family Scholarship Fund over the next three years.
